HOW TO LOG IN TO THE GDT PULSE AUCTION WEBSITE

Log in via MyGDT, the home for all GDT services.

- From www.globaldairytrade.info, click on 'Login to MyGDT'
- Log in using your own individual MyGDT login (email address) and password
- You do not need a different login or password
- Hover over GDT Pulse, and two options will appear
- Click on GDT Pulse | Auction to go to the live Auction Website, which will open 48 hours before a GDT Pulse Auction

The Auction Website is open 48 hours before each GDT Pulse Auction. You can view pre-auction information and submit auto-bids during this time.

When the GDT Pulse Auction starts, you can submit manual bids.

WHERE TO ACCESS GDT PULSE PRE-AUCTION SUPPLY INFORMATION

GDT Pulse pre-auction supply and forecast information will be posted as a bidder announcement on the homepage of the GDT Events Bidder Portal four days before each GDT Pulse Auction. Log in via MyGDT, the home for all GDT services.

- From www.globaldairytrade.info, click on 'Login to MyGDT'
- Log in using your own individual MyGDT login (email address) and password
- Hover over GDT Events, and three options will appear
- Click on GDT Events | Portal to access the Bidder Portal
- Under Announcements for bidders you will find a link to view the latest GDT Pulse Pre-Auction Supply Information.

Auction website functionality remains the same across the two service lines, but your General Settings can be customised for each.

For the first GDT Pulse Auction, user settings will be copied over from GDT Events (i.e., Copy Bid settings). From that point on, any changes users make in GDT Pulse will only be applied to GDT Pulse and any changes in GDT Events will only be applied to GDT Events.
